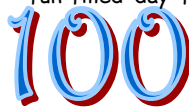
Join the Fun

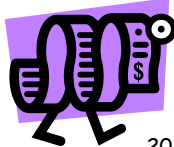
Come and join your child's classroom for a fun-filled day for the entire school! The students will celebrate the 100th day of school by rotating through 6 stations from 1 - 3 pm.

7 Mil Operating Levy

What does a Mil cost?

A mil produces \$1.00 in tax revenues for every \$1,000.00 of assessed value of property it is levied against. The assessed value is computed at 35% of the market value of a home.

House valued

at \$100,000:	At 7 Mil
Assessed Value at:	35%
Assessed Tax Value:	\$35,000
	(100,000 x .35)
Millage :	0.007

Cost / Year before

Reduction:	\$245
	(35,000 x .007)

Less 10% reduction

Actual cost of the levy for an owner of \$100,000 home is \$18.38 per month.

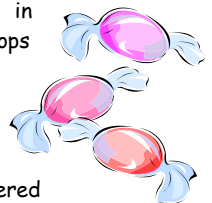

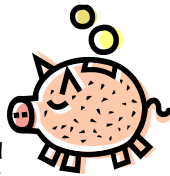

Under Ohio law, school districts must screen students who perform or show potential for performing at high levels of accomplishment. Students are screened in the following areas: superior cognitive ability, creativity and specific academic areas (reading/writing, math, social studies and science). If you would like your son/daughter screened/assessed in one or more of the above areas please fill out a referral form available from the school's office.

Students who were referred after the fall deadline (Oct. 15) will be assessed during the spring assessment period.

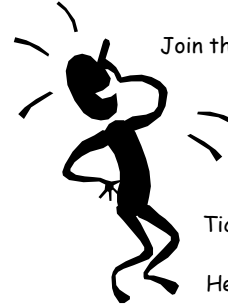
School Supply Machine
